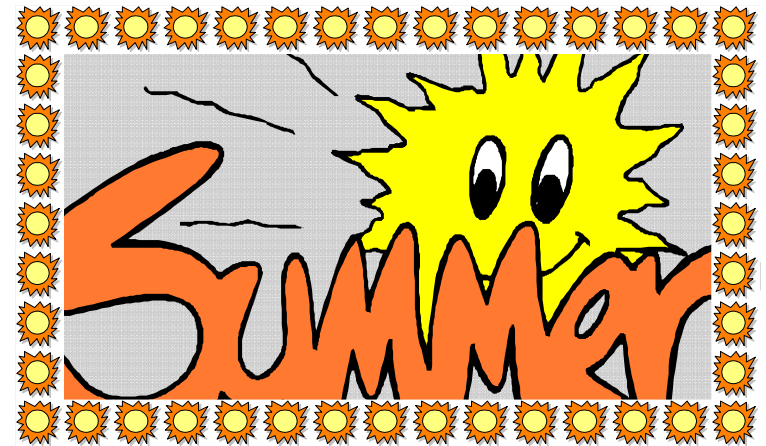

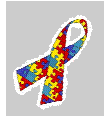

Our Mission

To create an environment in which children & youth are able to build the lifelong skills essential to becoming independent, responsible, caring & contributing members of our community.



Summer Program Description



The Amazing Kids Club offers an on-site therapeutic program for children and adolescents (ages 2-20 yrs) with an Autism Spectrum Disorder. It is considered a step-down program from the traditional one-to-one BHRS (wraparound) services. The Amazing Kids Club groups are funded by direct MA, CCBH, or self-pay. Any child with this funding, who meets the criteria for our groups, will be able to attend if deemed medically necessary in their psychological evaluation.

Amazing Kids Club will be offering an 11 week summer day treatment program, starting June 06, 2011 and concluding August 19, 2011. We will offer sessions Monday through Friday. Times will vary depending on the different groups.

Children and youth interested in our program will be evaluated during our intake process, first to assess the program's appropriateness for your child. Second, to place your child in a group that best meets his/her functional needs. Third, to develop an individualized treatment plan by our Master's Level Clinical Coordinators.

Family involvement and coordination is a strong component of our program structure. Daily activities are planned and treatment is implemented through the use of our multi-functional curriculum. Amazing Kids Club also uses a combination of therapeutic techniques: ABA (Applied Behavioral Analysis), VB (Verbal Behavior), Relational Therapy, Behavioral Therapy, PATHS (Promoting Alternate Thinking Strategies), etc.



Summer Program Activities



These are a few examples of some activities your child may experience this summer at The Amazing Kids Club!

- ~ Outings to promote Community Integration (parent contributions will be requested to cover the expenses)
- ~ Group Therapy
- ~ Sensory Activities (including our specialized sensory room)
- ~ Play Skills
- ~ Gross Motor Activities
- ~ Fine Motor Activities
- ~ Therapeutic Music, Art, and Drama Activities
- ~ Life Skills
- ~ Safety and self-help Skills
